**Single parent families has increased eight percent since 2009, to now almost one in three families. It also has risen in over two-thirds of Iowa counties. Iowa Kids Count 2018 (<http://datacenter.kidscount.org/data#IA>)

**Low birthweight has increased 13 percent since 2000. While remaining relatively stagnant the past few years at around 6.7 percent, the rate jumped to 6.9 percent this past year. Iowa Kids Count 2018 (<http://datacenter.kidscount.org/data#IA>)
