**While child poverty has been rising steadily since 2000 and has increased 16 percent since that time, it has started to drop and has decreased 26 percent since 2011. Iowa Kids Count 2017 (<http://datacenter.kidscount.org/data#IA>)

**Single parent families has increased 24 percent since 2000, going from one in four families to almost one in three families. It also has risen in all but seven Iowa counties. Iowa Kids Count 2017 (<http://datacenter.kidscount.org/data#IA>)

**Low birthweight has increased seven percent since 2000. However, the rate has remained relatively stagnant the past six years, hovering around 6.7 percent. Iowa Kids Count 2017 (<http://datacenter.kidscount.org/data#IA>)
